Descriptive Risk Rating	Interpretation
Moderate Risk	Moderate Risk is adequately controlled but further more stringent controls may be applied. Work can continue but corrective actions may need to be considered and a plan to implement them should be drawn up.

What Are The Hazards?

- Slips, trips and falls caused by inadequate or unsafe access/egress to places of work.
- Doors may become blocked and not accessible in an emergency.

Who Might be Harmed and How?	All employees, management and visitors, may suffer sprains, bruising or fractures if they trip over objects, such as goods on the floor, or slip on spillages.
What can we do about it?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Good housekeeping. - Clear exit routes. - No merchandising at doorway. - Clear deliveries immediately. - Functioning emergency exit doors and signage.
What Should an Employee do?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Maintain good housekeeping practices. - Never ignore a housekeeping hazard.
